SIMS Parents: All parents and carers were recently sent an email that gives access to the SIMS Parent app, which provides a secure facility to request updates to key information that the school holds for your child (contact details/allergies/medical information/consent etc). Flu Vaccinations: On Wednesday, our children from Reception to Year 6 were offered the annual flu vaccination, which is administered via a nasal spray. Alternatively you can contact your local GP's surgery, where they will also be able to offer the vaccination.
