Dear Parents / Carers,

I'm pleased to report that our Year 1 week and Reception week have both been very successful so we will be having both year groups back again next week. The children will need to remain in their existing bubbles (with the same children and adults that they were with before) and arrive and leave as before.

We will be contacting Year 6 families towards the end of next week with information about the bubbles that the children will be in and the timings of their school days. Based on current information we are likely to need a total of four bubbles for Year 6. If this is the case, bubbles A and B will attend school on Mondays and Tuesdays and bubbles C and D will attend on Thursdays and Fridays with the classrooms having a deep clean on Wednesdays.

If your child has any symptoms of COVID-19 they must not come to school and must be tested. If they show any symptoms while they are at school they will be isolated from the rest of their bubble and will need to be collected immediately. They will then need to be tested and we would recommend that the entire household is also tested. If the results are negative they can return to school when they are feeling better. If they are positive they will not be allowed back for at least 7 days (as per government guidance). The rest of the bubble's children and staff will need to self isolate for 14 days from this point and all parents of the children in the bubble will be notified. If the test result is negative then the bubble will be able to return to school.
