Pupil Safety After the tragic events of Wednesday evening we are continuing to work with our pupils, in particular from Years 5 and 6, about the dangers of knife crime. Internet Safety Awareness Day: As part of their national prevention programme, the Children's Society will be working across the country on Internet Safety on Tuesday 11th February.
